- **On My Way/Save My Spot** to shorten your wait at Edward-Elmhurst Immediate Cares and Walk in Clinics.
- **Virtual Assistant Chatbot** (“Eleanor”): Symptom checker for COVID-19 and general care navigation.

The 2020 Digital Health Most Wired program included four categories: domestic, ambulatory, long-term care and international. Scores are registered for each participating organization in eight segments: infrastructure, security, business/disaster recovery, administrative/supply chain, analytics/data management, interoperability/population health, patient engagement and clinical quality/safety.

The program does this by conducting an annual survey to identify, recognize and certify the adoption, implementation and use of information technology by healthcare provider organizations.
